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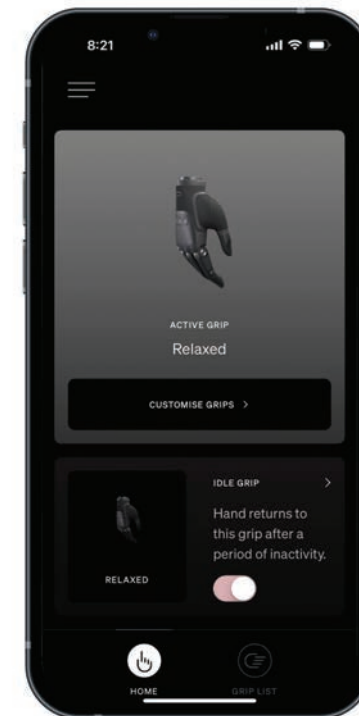

Replacement components and batteries are readily available, and annual servicing includes lubrication, tuning, upgrades, and general maintenance. prosthesis and the ease with which you can wash both hands together, means hygiene is also significantly improved.

All TASKA hands come with wrist options that include TASKA's HydroSeal™ Waterproofing Technology, allowing submersion past the wrist.

Whether it's shaking hands, holding a broom or using utensils, the flexible fingers on the TASKA hand deliver a more secure grip on a wider range of objects. Smart buttons and an intuitive changing strategy mean it's simple to switch

between grips, while a unique resettable Knuckle Release feature prevents damage to the fingers.

In addition, optimised Wrist Flexion - which is built-in to every one of our hands - mimics natural movement and makes everyday tasks like drinking from a glass that much easier.

If you want to appreciate what a big deal the ‘little things’
are, spend fifteen minutes chatting with Korrin Barrett.

“Just being able to hold a knife. You can’t imagine
what that meant.” Korrin said of a recent restaurant
experience with her TASKA CX™. Her friend asked
(as usual), ‘Would you like me to cut your food for you?’
and Korrin could say, ‘No, I’ve got this.’

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Korrin is a quad amputee. She lost both her legs below
the knee and the fingers of her left hand, and her
right arm to mid-forearm from sepsis caused by an
undetected perforated bowel. She spent days in an
induced coma and months in the hospital, relearning to
be independent.

Korrin is popular on the public speaking circuit, talking
about resilience. “Before this happened, I took so many
things for granted. It was a major shift in appreciation
and gratitude.”

Korrin is an ambassador for organisations and ideas that
are personal to her. It’s one of the reasons she clicked with
TASKA. “As a Kiwi, I love that it’s New Zealand-made,”
Korrin adds with a patriotic tone. Korrin says there’s a
family feeling when she visits TASKA headquarters -
she feels she’s not just a number.

Korrin likes matching wardrobe to hand. “I love that the
TASKA CX is quite feminine, and I love changing the
Coverplates.” Her favourite plate for evening functions
is the white one. “Best of all, I can hold a glass of wine.”
Korrin’s previous hand had a grip malfunction and
wouldn’t let go of the wine glass. “That was quite the
taxi ride home!” she laughs. “This new hand has been a
real jump in quality and trust for me.”

Working with horses is physically demanding with many daily activities that could potentially damage a prosthetic.

“I had become so sick of breaking hands that I gave up wearing them altogether.” But that all changed when Jodie was introduced to the TASKA hand.

“I worry less and am much more confident trying new things without the fear of damaging my hand. Being able to wash my hands during the pandemic made such a difference.”

“The versatility is amazing too. I can do so much more now

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- from work in the barn to hiking, camping and (of course) riding! I can move wheelbarrows, use a leaf blower, and even do all those tricky little tasks you never think about, like opening a bag of chips.”

The other major benefit of the TASKA hand for Jodie, is the appearance. “I work with people who face challenges around cognitive function, and a prosthetic hand has the potential to produce either a very positive, or a very negative response from them. But they love it!”, she says.

Adrian’s primary reason for choosing TASKA was the robustness of the hand.

“When I first picked up the hand, I could feel the build quality; it didn’t feel flimsy or weak. The other reason was the functionality of the hand. The electrically opposable thumb and the grip button on the hand made it easier to change between grips.”

Many of Adrian’s interests, like working on his bike, need a great deal of fine motor work and the use of multiple grips.

“Some tasks require you to have the ability to switch between grips like a normal hand. So having access to buttons to cycle through your favourite grips mid-task and not relying on the app would have to be my most liked feature.”

Then, there are the everyday activities. “Being able to use the hand in and around water greatly assists with cleaning hands and washing up duties. Then there’s switching between holding a cup and holding a knife using the buttons on the hand.”



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
